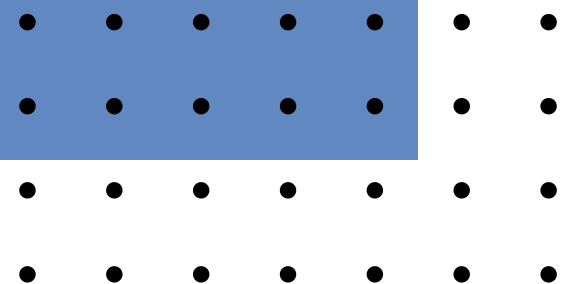

Who we are

Obre't'ebre is a non-profit youth organization, founded in 2005 to promote universal values such as solidarity, tolerance, and respect, through local, regional, and international projects.

The main objectives of the association are: to foster the social inclusion of young people, generate socio-community actions to foster social cohesion and the values of cooperation, tolerance, respect, and justice, foster participation to educate active citizenship, and promote volunteering as a tool for social cohesion. In addition to informing, advising, coordinating, and managing international mobility programs in the field of non-formal education. To achieve its goals, the association works with the following programs: awareness, mobility, participation, and training.



What do we do?

Local training



We work for the community development offering courses so we can facilitate the job insertion of the youth in Terres de l'Ebre.

International mobility



By our mobility office we help young people to have an educational international experience in our area or abroad by participating in Youth Exchange, Workcamps, Individual or Groupal Voluntary or Internships.

Social inclusion



We organize groups of volunteers to teach the language to non-catalan speakers and to help them including in our society.

Our team

The board

...is formed by a group of people dedicated voluntary to the governance of the entity.

The professional technical team

... is formed by a multidisciplinary team of professionals. It consists of 3-5 people working on different projects of the organization.

Volunteering

Volunteering is a big part of the Obre't Ebre spirit, essential for the organization to function optimally. They help us make our environment more creative, comfortable and interesting for everyone. Volunteers are working in our linguistic exchanges to teach catalan language to migrant community or international youth.



Volunteer's tasks

HOURS: between 30 and 35h
+ catalan lessons 2 h per week



Network: Prepare and realize activities with the other volunteers from different projects in Obre't'ebre.



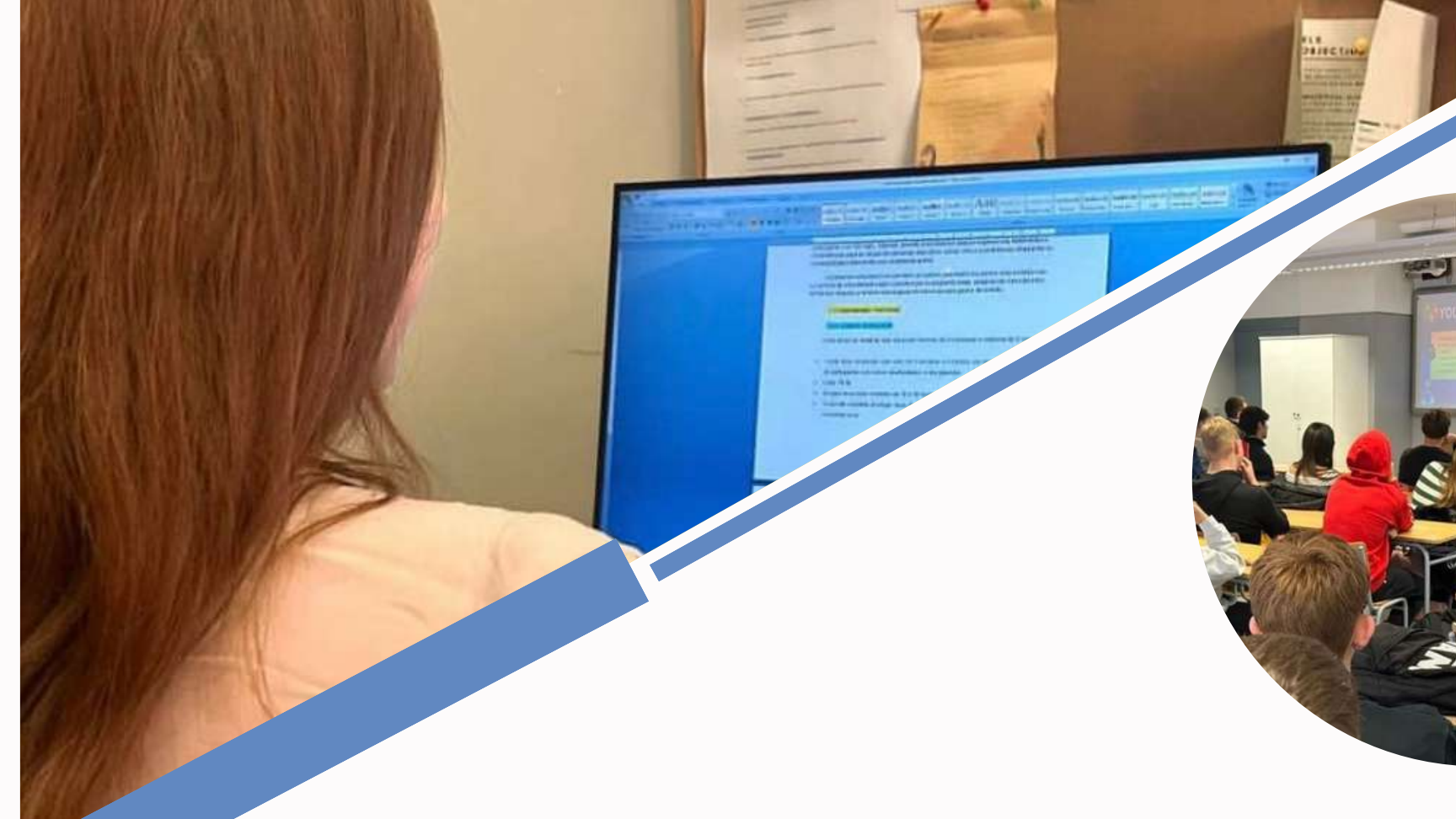
International or national exchanges/camps: Help to prepare the activities for the International or national work camp for summer and be part of it as a monitor.



Social network support by promoting the actions and activities in Obre't Ebre and also in the hosting organisation of the other ESC



Organize talks in other institutions about the experience of being a volunteer or about informing about the different EU programs.



Diffusion of ECS and local participation: the volunteers need to participate at least in 3 different talks (schools, radio, etc) to explain the experience, and to participate in 6 different local actions to get to know the community where they are living (environmental, social, cultural...)

Volunteer's tasks

Personal Project: Preparing your project is a compulsory activity for your personal development. Always need to coordinate with your hosting organization.





Volunteer's profile

- Is open-minded towards differences and has an unconditional respect for the others
- Is interested in working with diversity of people
- Is willing to do the tasks
- Has previous experience in volunteering at the local level
- Has a personal interest in the topic covered by the association
- Is highly motivated to learn Catalan and Spanish
- Is highly motivated to have relations with the community

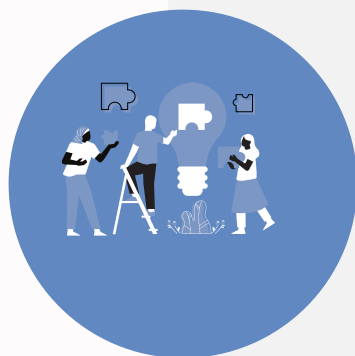
Practical arrangements



- The shopping list will be done by the volunteers
- The food will be delivered every 2 weeks by a supermarket



- Facilities and rooms (4-6 double beds) are shared.
- Free WIFI
- Sharing the house with other projects is possible.
- Deposit of 100 euros on arrival. Returned at the end if belongings are fine



- Working hours maximum 35 hours per week
- 2 h language per week (Catalan)
- Personal project
- If working weekends, it will be compensated during the week
- 2 days off per month



- The language course will consist of Catalan language (the Official Language in Catalonia) and it will be strengthened with language, 2 hours per week (in volunteering or formal courses)



- Monthly pocket money at the beginning of each month (6 euros per day)

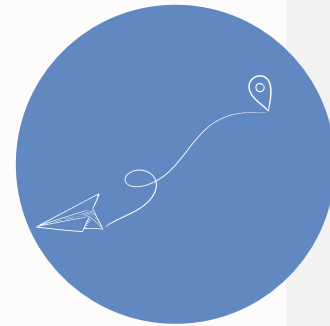


- EU citizen, bring your European Health Insurance Card. For non-EU citizens, we have to apply to Henner Insurance
- Spanish community: do not forget to bring your Social Security Number

Practical arrangements



- Volunteers have a mentor. Individual mentoring and group mentoring with other volunteers are compulsory
- Volunteers need to assist with the compulsory training by the National Agency: 1 on arrival and 1 mid-term evaluation.



- Travel costs will be reimbursed after submitting tickets, bills, boarding passes, etc
- Travel costs are based on EU travel grant accordingly to the ESC program



- Visa costs can be covered. First, ask us about the assigned amount
- Ask us for the supporting letters on time
- Make sure of the procedures and dates with your embassy to obtain the visa



- Each volunteer will have a bike, helmet, and a bike lock
- On arrival, volunteers need to know that helmet (10 Euros), bike lock (10 Euros), and bike (60 Euros) are priced at 80 Euros. If volunteers lose, break, or damage the items they will need to replace them
